Hi Everyone,

Have you all adjusted to the new year? Hard to believe that it's 2011 already. And it's very, very hard to believe that 2011 is New Beginnings SPCA's 20th anniversary!!!

During 2010 we adopted out 162 animals, this is up from 143 in 2009. Unfortunately we also had 13 that died, all of natural causes. 12 were returned to owner and 1 was transferred to another sanctuary to live out his life. This was Frankie our Scottish Fold/Manx if you remember him. We sure miss him but am very grateful that he has a great place to live out his life in a safe environment and is well taken care of & loved. 2010 was a bit rough for a whole lot of people and we did our best to keep pets with their people by providing emergency vet care and spay neuter funds. Unfortunately 2010 was also a bit rough on us and didn't have the funds to do it all. We sure hope that 2011 picks up for everyone!

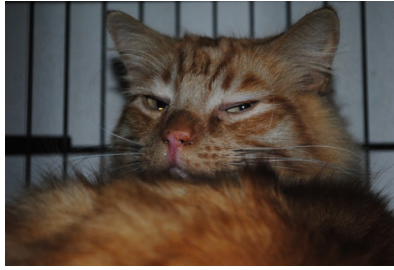
We appreciate all that each and everyone of you do for us and the animals. Hope you continue with your support. We look forward to the next 20 years!

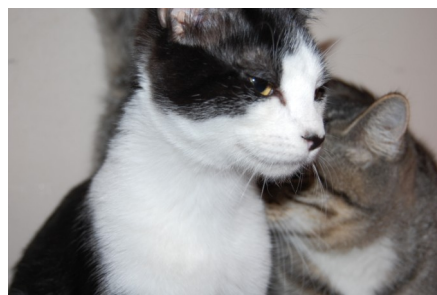

4th Annual

Chili Feed Fund-Raiser

NBSPCA will be sponsoring its 4th Annual Chili Feed on Saturday Feb 26th from 5 pm to 7 pm. This is an all you can eat affair for only \$5. There will be lots of different types of chili including regular, spicy, vegetarian, white chili, etc. In addition the low price includes all the toppings, soda and cornbread. There will also be desserts that you can purchase for \$1 - \$2. We'll also have a couple of raffles going, including a 50/25/25 cash raffle.

The Feed will be held at the Littlebrook Clubhouse at 200 Littlebrook Lane in Green. If you are coming from I-5, take exit 119. Turn right at the second traffic light onto Carnes Rd. Go to the flashing red light and turn left onto Happy Valley Road. Go about 1/4 mile and turn right onto Little Valley Rd. Go about 1/2 mile and turn right onto Littlebrook Ln. The clubhouse parking lot is just **past** the first left.

If you are coming through town, come towards Green on Old Hwy 99. Make a right at the light onto Happy Valley Road. Go about 1/4 mile **past** the flashing red light and turn right onto Little Valley Rd. Go about 1/2 mile and turn right onto Littlebrook Ln. The clubhouse parking lot is just **past** the first left.

If the gates are closed, go to the call box and enter 210. Someone will answer the phone in the clubhouse and buzz you in. The parking lot is on the small side so car pooling is encouraged.
